- 1. TO AVOID MILDEW, SET YOU'RE A/C THERMOSTAT AT 78 F.
- 2. DO NOT TURN OF THE BREAKERS SWITCHES.
- 3. IF WATER CONTINUES TO RUN IN THE TOILET AFTER FLUSHING, REPLACE THE FLAPPER A.S.A.P. TO PREVENT FLOOD.
- 4. REMOVE ALL THE PERISHABLE FOOD FROM THE REFRIGERATOR.
- 5. TURN OFF FAUCETS TIGHTLY, IF THEY CONTINUE TO DRIP CALL TOTAL HVAC OR OUR OFFICE FOR REPAIR.
- REMOVE INFLAMMABLE ITEMS FROM YOUR A/C UNIT. THE A/C CLOSET IN NOT FOR STORAGE. A/C UNIT DOORS MUST BE LOCKED. CHECK FOR LEAKS OR WETNESS BEFORE YOU LEAVE.
- 7. LEAVE A KEY WITH TRUSTED FRIEND TO PERIODICALLY CHECK YOUR APARTMENT AND A/C UNIT (OR TO RESET YOUR THERMOSTAT IN CASE OF A POWER FAILURE).
- 8. EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION MUST BE IN THE OFFICE RECORDS.
- 9. THE OFFICE MUST HAVE AN EXTRA APARTMENT KEY IN CASE OF FIRE, FLOOD OR ANY EMERGENCY.
- 10. SEND AN AUTHORIZATION LETTER TO THE OFFICE IF ANY IMMEDIATE RELATIVE WILL BE OCCUPYING YOUR APARTMENT IN YOUR ABSENCE.
- 11. REMOVE EVERY ITEM AND ANY FURNITURE FROM YOUR TERRACE. HURRICANE SEASON STARTS JUNE 1ST AND ENDS NOVEMBER 30ST.
